



Nancy Skinner has 10 to 1 Cash on Hand advantage

Skinner reports \$1.1 million COH vs. \$104,000 for Swanson

Skinner also secures SEIU and AFSCME District Council endorsements

Filings released today show Nancy Skinner with a commanding 10 to 1 Cash on Hand advantage over her opponent Sandre Swanson, and a 17 to 1 advantage over Katherine Welch.

The filing, which covered the period 7/1/15 to 12/31/15 showed Skinner with another stellar fundraising showing and continuing to widen her cash-on-hand advantage.
