Nancy Skinner has been endorsed by the Brady Campaign to Prevent Gun Violence, the nation's largest and most effective organization advocating for sensible gun laws and efforts to prevent gun deaths and violence.

"Nancy Skinner took on the Gun Lobby and successfully passed groundbreaking laws to make our communities safer," stated Peggy McCrum, President of the 27 California Chapters of the Brady Campaign to Prevent Gun Violence. "She closed a loophole in California's assault weapons ban and provided families a new tool to get guns out of the hands of someone who is threatening harm. We need courageous leaders like Nancy Skinner in the State Senate!"

Nancy Skinner has been one of California's leading gun control advocates. She authored AB1014 which allows family members to petition to have guns removed from an individual who is a threat to themselves or others. She authored AB48 which banned large capacity ammunition magazines.

In 2014, Nancy Skinner received the prestigious "Excellence in Leadership" award from the Brady Campaign.

The Brady Campaign has a strong presence in California which leads the nation in enacting strong legislation to reduce gun violence. From 1980 to 2014 gun deaths in California have declined by 58%, while only declining by 27% in the rest of the nation.

Earlier this week, Nancy Skinner announced that her campaign had been endorsed by the Sierra Club, California.
